Complex aromas of brioche, honey, toasted almonds, and oyster shell, it tracks smoothly to a lingering candied-lemon finish
- 105 De Castelnau Blanc de Blanc 2007/2008 France.** £96
A rich and complex bouquet. the palate expresses roasted almonds and hazelnuts while figs, candied lemon and biscuit notes combine to form an intense and lingering finish
- 106 Deutz Brut Classic NV France** £85
The wine initially displays notes of white flowers, toast, marzipan, and ripe pears. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied and elegant with the freshness of Chardonnay and richness of Pinot Noir. Overall, the wine is well-rounded with a fruity finish.

- 108 De Castelnau Brut Rosé NV France** £94
Slightly salmon, pink grapefruit in colour. On the nose is subtle, wild strawberries and on the palate, it is soft and rich but still retains a lovely lightness of touch



Sparkling Wine

109 Villa Sandi Prosecco Brut DOCG Millesimato 2022 Italy £40

Brilliant silver-grey with persistent, fine mousse. Aromas of white peach, sugar melon, acacia blossom and young pears. A palate with clear fruit core and beautiful freshness, generous soft mousse and a clear, fruit accentuated finish

110 Louis Bouillot, Crémant de Bourgogne NV France £39

A complex nose with aromas of peach and then nuances of flowers. Lively fresh with a good harmony between fruit and citrus

111 Hattingley Valley, English Sparkling, Classic reserve Brut NV England £68

Blend: 48% Chardonnay, 33% Pinot Noir, 17% Pinot Meunier & 2% Pinot Gris

A pale gold with a well-developed nose showing a hint of autolysis with subtle oak character. It is well-balanced on the palate showing crisp acidity and fine mousse. It has delicate toasty characteristics from the ageing on lees whilst the gentle oak flavour adds complexity

112 Anna De Codorniu Blanc de Blancs Reserva NV Spain £36

Blend: Chardonnay, Parellada, Macabeo & Xarel-lo

Brilliant yellow colour with green reflections. Fine, persistent bubbles forming continuous beads. Citrusy and tropical fruit notes on the nose, along with more complex ageing aromas (toast, brioche). Creamy on the palate, wide and long-lasting. It is highly versatile and easy to pair with a great variety of food

113 Villa Sandi Prosecco Superiore Cartizze La Rivetta Italy £58

They give floral wines of great persistence and elegance, with hints of fruit and aromatic herbs. Of the 107 HA designated as Cartizze DOGC, Villa Sandi owns 1.5 HA with La Rivetta vineyard with the average age of vines at 45 years old

Sparkling Rosé

114 Louis Bouillot Perle d'Aurore Crémant Rosé France £42

Pinot Noir comes from the Côte d'Or, Gamay from the South of Burgundy, and Chardonnay near Mâcon city. A Deep bouquet of small red fruit, raspberries, and redcurrants, which turns into complex marmalade notes after a few minutes in the glass. Crisp palate with citrus notes and a fine fruity finish



Non-Alcoholic Wines

Red

Odd Bird – The world's first low intervention wine – liberated from alcohol £30
Supple blend of Merlot and Pinot Noir from Breganze, a town in the Veneto region of Italy. Fermented spontaneously, hand harvested, 100% organic and micro vinified in barriques and tonneaux

White

Odd Bird – The world's first low intervention wine – liberated from alcohol £30
Rich and Powerful with intense red fruit aromas and a long spicy finish

Moa Gürbüzer started Oddbird in 2013. Her vision was to question and change the alcohol norms of society by creating world class wines but liberating them from alcohol. Today Oddbird is the largest producer of wines liberated from alcohol in Scandinavia.

Odd bird is a Swedish winery, which develops, produces, and distributes non-alcoholic premium wines. Even without alcohol, it is possible to enjoy a wine. The Odd bird wines have their legacy from old classical handicraft, but modern non-alcoholic wines are created with a new patented technology.

Non-Alcoholic Sparkling

ALT. Sparkling Organic Chardonnay £30
A crisp and refreshing non-alcoholic sparkling white wine made with 100% Chardonnay grapes from sandy and calcareous soils in southern Spain. Crisp acidity and strong effervescence with hints of green apples and citrus peel accompanied with a floral aroma

ALT. Sparkling Organic Rosé £30
ALT. Sparkling Organic Rosé is a fresh and aromatic non-alcoholic sparkling rosé wine made with 100% Tempranillo grapes from sandy and calcareous soils in the middle of Spain. Crisp acidity and strong effervescence with hints of summer berries and watermelon accompanied by an aromatic aroma

European Wine

Slovenia

Gasper Rebula 2019 £52

This white wine is light straw in colour, the fresh and fruity nose displaying hints of green apple, pear, peach and citrus. The palate is crisp and rounded with a silky texture

Croatia

Matošević Grimalda Red Istria 2019 £65

The palate is fresh and juicy, with gentle tannins, an excellent structure and lifted minerality on the close. The 2019 'Grimalda' Red is the first organic certified vintage of this Teran and Merlot blend in ratios of 85-15 from a terraced, sunny, single vineyard in Central Istria, near the village of Grimalda

Armenia

Zorah Karasi Areni Noir 2020 £80

The palate reflects the exotic nose with hints of soft red fruits, dried mountain herbs and wild earth. Generous and soft, with balanced, full-bodied structure and mature silky ripe tannins before a long, evolved mineral finish

Georgia

Tbilvino Saperavi Red Kakheti 2021 £36

This is 100% Saperavi – the grapes that make it are all hand-selected. It has a deep ruby red colour, good depth, complexity, and an authentic local character. There are hints of coffee, cinnamon and vanilla overlaying black fruit, particularly blackberry. On the palate, it displays typical Saperavi notes of cassis and a hint of liquorice, along with good acidity and slightly more tannin grip than other Saperavis



White Wine

France

La Vallée de la Loire

201 Château du Cléray Muscadet de sèvre et Maine sur Lie 2021 £38
Pale Gold. Complex, with floral, minty, and exotic fruit notes. Fresh on the attack, round and well balanced on the palate bringing out minty and floral notes again on the finish

202 Sauvion 'Les Bosquets' Vouvray 2021/2022 £38
Easy to drink- fresh and soft, this wine has aromas of honey and acacias. Off-dry style, (Chenin Blanc)

203 Pouilly - Fumé Domaine Chauveau 2022. £39
Stylish expression of Sauvignon Blanc, with an herbaceous bite and gunflint notes on the finish

205 Domaine Paul Doucet & Fils Sancerre, Loire Valley 2022 £50
Pale golden with silvery glints. Very aromatic, rich and complex nose, melting floral (lily of the valley, white lilac) and expressive with hints of peach, mandarin. Elegant and refreshing with overtones of gooseberry and citrus flavours on the palate. Intense and aromatic with tropical fruit flavours

L 'Alsace

206 Princes Abbes Pinot Gris Schlumberger 2017. £46
Distinctive, refined nose showing delicate smoky and spicy notes with white peach. Aromatic finish

La Bourgogne

Chablis

207 Pascal Bouchard Chablis Le Classique 2022 £41
Subtle aromas of tree fruit and hints of citrus show nicely in this elegant unoaked Chardonnay

208 Pascal Bouchard Chablis Grand Cru Vaudésir 2018 £120
'Vaudésirs' is nestled in a micro-valley, meaning that each slope benefits from different exposure to the sun. Fermented in oak barrels that are 2 to 5 years old to preserve the minerality that is characteristic of this terroir. 12 months in oak barrels, followed by a final 2 months of ageing in stainless steel tanks. With pleasing minerality, toasted, oak notes, suppleness, and remarkable ageing potential

Mâconnais

209 Pouilly - Fuissé Les Deux Terroirs, Mommessin 2022. £58
A classic Burgundy Chardonnay, rich and buttery with lovely acidity

211 Ropiteau Macon-Lugny 2021 £42
Vinification takes place in thermo-regulated stainless-steel tanks. The wine is partially aged in tanks and partially aged in barrels. A fresh and complex with flavours of white flowers and dried fruits with subtle notes of acacia. Medium-body, rich and balanced wine with a slightly spicy finish



Côte De Beaune

213 Corton Charlemagne, Grand Cru, Meo-Camuzet 2011 £350

A fresh and good acidity. Pale lemon yellow with a light tropical note on the nose and minerals. Flavours include toasted nuts, brioche, and butter

214 Puligny Montrachet Jacques Carillon 2020 £175

A wine that combines a delicate taste with a full body and mineral tones. Barrels for 1 year, with 20% new barrels, then 6 months in stainless steel vats. The 2020 Puligny-Montrachet Village mingles aromas of citrus oil with hints of nutmeg, white flowers and almonds. Medium to full-bodied, with tangy acids and a pretty core of fruit, it concludes with promising length. It's the finest rendition of this cuvée since 2017

215 Chassagne-Montrachet Morgeot 2020 £185

The 2020 Chassagne-Montrachet Morgeot 1er Cru Rouge taken from a one-year old barrel, has a well-defined bouquet with bright red cherries and cranberry fruit. Very intense. The palate is medium-bodied with a chalky entry with very fine tannins, lightly spiced with quite a persistent finish

514 Corton Charlemagne Cru Lucien, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy 2014 £600

100% Chardonnay. The 2014 Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru, which is sourced from the Pernand side of the hill, has a precise bouquet with lemon peel, granite, and smoky notes, almost Puligny-like in terms of its reserve. The palate is fresh and vibrant with good body, fine tension thanks to that keen line of acidity, with hints of orange peel towards the finish.

Southern Rhône

216 Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc 2020 £74

This stunning white Rhone is a brilliant pale gold with pear, apricot notes. Mineral notes and a balance aromatic fruit, Clairette/Grenache Blanc/Roussanne

Bordeaux – Graves

212 Château de Chantegrive Caroline Blanc 2017 £48

The 2017 Château de Chantegrive Caroline is another beautiful white from this vintage. Offering plenty of pineapple and citrus fruits, medium-bodied richness, and nicely integrated acidity, it has plenty of oomph and texture while still showing the fresher, more vibrant side to the vintage

Italy

217 Fedele Catarrato Pinot Grigio Vegan & Organic 2022 £36

Predominantly Catarrato, a widely planted Sicilian variety which gives texture and tropical fruit flavours to the wine. Pinot Grigio adds a fresh, light stone fruit character 'A dry white with a textured palate of tropical fruit, offset with fresh citrus notes'. Vegetarian and Vegan

218 Gavi di Gavi (Piemonte) 2022 £38

The result is a complex wine with delicious white peach notes on the nose leading onto more stone fruit on the palate as well as delicious honeydew melon. Cortese grape variety

219 Pecorino 2021 £36

A pure, yet lively aroma with mineral and lime leaf notes, leads to an immediately charming palate that is both delicate & persistent. Great balance between body, freshness and exotic fruit flavours



Spain

220 Raimat Saira Albariño 2022 £38

Refreshing wine with enjoyable aromas of dried flowers and lemon peel with nuances of green apple and wet grass

221 Cune Monopole Blanco 2021 £36

This unoaked Viura is bright straw yellow hints of green, followed by aromas of fine citrus and floral with a touch of grapefruit and orange blossom. A balanced acidity. 100 % Viura

South Africa

222 Ken Forrester 'The FMC' Chenin Blanc 2021/2022 £72

Layer upon layer of candied lemon, dried apricot, and vanilla, with a touch of honey and spice supported by a gentle oak and a lovely freshness

New Zealand

223 Falconhead Viognier 2023 £40

Falconhead Hawkes Bay Viognier has apricot, musk and orange blossom aromas are complimented by a hint of vanilla from the barrel. Subtle oak continues to influence the palate combined with a soft acidity. The palate is full bodied with sweet fruit flavours of pear and apricot

224 Esk Valley Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough 2022 £36

The Esk Valley Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough is a beautifully refreshing wine with zesty citrus flavours and a touch of fresh herbs. It has a lovely mineral character with a zesty acidity, leading to a long, dry finish. This is a perfect wine for enjoying on a warm summer's day

225 Dog Point Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2022 £44

Sauvignon Blanc is the flagship varietal of New Zealand and is typically a very crisp aromatic wine with notes of grapefruit, tropical fruit and cut grass

Chile

226 Altitudes Gran Reserve Viognier Chile 2021 £34

This Viognier Gran Reserva is medium-full bodied with rich aromas of citrus, apricot and fresh pears. The palate is rich as well with floral, honeyed and citrus flavours and a touch of minerality



Argentina

227 Catena Alta Chardonnay 2019 £55

Catena Alta is an assemblage of historic rows within the Catena family State vineyards. The blend of these historic rows, like the combination of sounds that create a symphony, gives us highly aromatic and elegant wine that speaks for the terroir and the vines that have been tended by the four generations of the Catena Family. 'Alta' means high in Spanish. This makes reference to the high altitude vineyards from where the grapes are sourced, and to the high end wines that are produced with this special grapes. A remarkable white wine, with flavours of pear, apricot and lemon. There are subtle hints of white flowers and warm, smoky notes on the finish

250 Inacayal Torrontes Mendoza 2020 £36

Delicate pale yellow colour with steel hues. Aromas displaying mineral and floral notes typically jasmine, geranium, orange blossom, together with fruit notes of lychee. In the mouth it is dry, light, fresh and well balanced. The wine has high but clean acidity, citrus flavours and lightly unctuous

United States of America

228 Bogle Chardonnay 2018/2019/2020 £48

A rich mouthfeel and creamy textures with spicy American oak notes of butterscotch and vanilla are the perfect balance to the freshness and acidity of this multifaceted wine

Australia

229 Not Your Grandma's Riesling Eden Valley 2018/2021 £38

Fresh and floral, there's ample citrus and orchid fruits. The wine has a great length with the refreshing acidity. It works perfectly with or without food

Germany

230 Dr Loosen Dry Slate Red Riesling 2021 £38

Dr Loosen 'Red Slate' Riesling is a lovely dry wine produced with fruit sourced from estate-owned vineyards planted on red slate soils in the villages of Erden and Ürzig. A well-balanced dry Riesling from estate vineyards that show the distinctively forceful minerality of red slate soils

Beaujolais

301 Fleurie Mommessin 2022 £38

It offers a rich nose of black fruit and floral with hints of spice and dark chocolate. The mouth is greedy, ample, velvety, round, elegant, fine and tender with silky tannins

302 Mommessin Château de Pierreux Brouilly 2021 £42

Brilliant deep ruby in colour with an elegant aroma of soft floral notes of violet and peonies

La Vallée du Rhône

303 Domaine de Longue Toque, Gigondas 2016 £53

Rich and Powerful with intense red fruit aromas and a long spicy finish

304 Châteauneuf de Pape La Bastide Saint Dominique 2020/2021 £78

Inky ruby colour, this Rhone ranger displays roasted dark berry, cherry preserve and plum aromas

305 Crozes-Hermitage Rouge 2018/2020 £65

An intense ruby red with an abundance of red fruits on the nose by an undertone of violets. A silky full-bodied wine, well balanced and true to Crozes-Hermitage. Syrah grape variety

Côte – Rôtie, Maison Les Alexandrins 2020 £120

98% Syrah and Viognier 2%. A vintage that was particularly sunny has given a powerful but well-balanced wine, with a fine velvety tannins and spicy notes. Serving suggestion: decanted and drink in its youth

Côte de Beaune

306 Gilbert et Christine Felettig, Nuits-Saint-Georges 2021 £140

Concentrated and balanced, our Nuits-Saint-Georges 2021 shows a deep ruby color. The nose combines intense aromas of blackcurrant and violet. The palate is generous and delicate with velvety tannins. The finish of this perfumed wine is fresh and sapid

307 Albert Bichot, Secret de Famille, Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2018/2021 £54

This charming wine features predominant fruity aromas of blackcurrant and wild red berries. Velvety and silky, this wine boasts soft, balanced structure on the palate, which ends with a delicate finish reminiscent of red fruit. Grapes harvested in the region of Chambolle-Musigny, Pommard and Nuits Saint Georges

Saint Émilion

308 Château Billeron Bouquey, Grand Cru 2020 £41
A rich, mouth-drying tannic structure, which is balanced by the more juicy characteristics of plum and black cherry fruit, along with chocolate, sweet spice, vanilla and tobacco

Pomerol

309 Ballade de La Pointe Pomerol 2019 £75
Merlot 84 %, Cabernet franc 16 %. Red and black fruit aromas mingle on the nose such as redcurrant, blackcurrant, wild berries. The palate is soft and full of a well-balanced velvety tannic framework. The finish is well structured, juicy, and long finish

Margaux

310 La Bastide Dauzac 2018 £60
Deep purple colour with ruby undertone. Very soft and subtle tannins, well balance wine with a silk texture

Saint Julien

312 Les Fiefs de Lagrange 2015 £70
The wine is characterized by round tannins, aromas of red and black fruits

313 Château Gloria 2017/2018 £96
Deep in colour and rich, cassis-laden and cedary on the palate

Saint-Estèphe

314 Château Meyney 2013/2015 £105
Full bodied wine, well rounded and structured, 65% Cab sav, 25% Merlot and 10% of Petit Verdot

Pauillac

501 Lacoste Borie 2018 £92
The 2018 Lacoste-Borie is a blend of 61% Cabernet Sauvignon, 29% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc. The palate is medium bodied with a beautiful ruby red colour, very intense red berries aromas and spicy notes and cassis. Fruity and silky tannins on the palate

503 Château Pedesclaux 2014/2015 £120
The 2015 Pedesclaux is a blend of 52% Cabernet Sauvignon, 42% Merlot and 6% Petit Verdot that spent 18 months in barrel, 60% new and 40% one year old. Medium garnet-purple in colour, it has an earthy nose with dried herbs and garrigue notes over a core of red currants and black berries plus a touch of cedar chest. The medium-bodied palate is fine and fresh with juicy red and black fruits and a chewy finish



Italy

Puglia, South 'Italy Heel'

316 Ducale Salice Salentino Reserva 2019 £36

This is a combination of two Italian grapes, Negroamaro (80%) and Malvasia (20%). It's a classic wine from the South of Italy that delivers a rich taste of mature fruit with notes of cherry, raisins, and leather

Piedmont, North West

317 Barolo DOCG Ascheri Sorano 2018/2019 £88

Intense tar with scent of dry flowers, truffles, and sweet spices. Balance and mature tannins contribute to its harmony, distinction, and intensity

318 Prunotto Pian Romualdo Barbera d'Alba 2021 £58

An exceptional single vineyard oaked Barbera, with a complex, elegant nose of Blackberries and spice. Rich and seamless on the palate

Veneto, North East

319 Amarone Della Valpolicella 'Torre del Falasco' 2017/2018 £75

Amarone della Valpolicella is an intensely flavoured dry red wine made from dried (passito) grapes. Aroma of ripe plums, spice which give a solid tannin structure and dried cherry fruit character. A bitter cherry chocolate twist characteristic of a good Amarone. Silky and long finish

Tuscany, Central

320 Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Bottega 2017 £88

Made from hand harvested fruit, this fine wine is dry and warm to taste, robust yet soft

321 Villa Saletta, Saletta Ricardi 2015 £72

Hand-picking 100% Sangiovese grapes to make this rich and complex wine. The palate is savoury, full, and ample with supple and silky tannins

322 Villa Saletta, Saletta Giulia 2015 £72

Notes of spice and toasted oak with aromas of berry fruit, this is an elegant blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc and a pleasant finish

Portugal

315 Quinta Da Leda Douro 2019 £90

A deep red colour. Its aroma is intense and complex, which dominates plum, cassis, resin, cedar, cloves and nutmeg. It has still highlight aromas of violet and some chocolate, always in perfect harmony with discreet wood, well integrated and excellent quality. In the mouth reveals great elegance, being remarkable, its volume, balanced acidity, excellent quality tannins and black fruit aromas, spices and floral. Very long and great harmony



Spain

Cigales

323 Museum Reserva 2015/2016 £49

100% Tinta del Pais. The taste is elegant, subtle, and very silky. There are aromas of fruit and well-polished tannins due to passing through the wood. The aftertaste is long. Ruby red with garnet reflections. Complex and delicate nose with outstanding roasted and wood notes from aging, together with liquorice, red fruit, balsamic and minerals

Rioja

324 Cune Rioja Gran Reserva 2017 £44

Attractive aroma of blackberries, blackcurrants and raspberries blended with a hint of spice and vanilla. Complex and elegant on the palate with fine tannins and a good length

Ribera del Duero

325 Rioja Imperial Gran Reserva 2012 £94

Full garnet in colour expressing elegant autumn berry fruits, coffee, caramel, and cinnamon. The palate is finely structured with dried fruit, plums, and damsons

326 Condado de Haza Crianza DO 2019 £46

Intense floral and fruity aromas on the nose. Smooth in the mouth with highlight of redcurrant, vanilla with smoky notes. 100% Tempranillo

Australia

South Australia, McLaren Vale

327 Hedonist Shiraz 2019 £40

A blend with deep russet red, earthy aromas of savoury oak and dark cherries with a little stewed rhubarb. Spice and cinnamon on the palate over a robust and generous body. Grenache/Shiraz/Mataro

South Africa

328 Painted Wolf 'Guillermo' Pinotage 2020 £40

An elegant and balanced wine packed with flavours of ripe blueberry and mulberry, exotic spice, and creamy vanilla with ripe tannins

Chile

Caliterra's Pétreo wines refer to the clay and sedimentary schists found in this premium hillside vineyard plot. Only Carménère and Malbec vines are planted in these unique soils. Barrel fermented and then matured in oak for 18 months, the Pétreo Carménère is an exceptional, vibrant example of Chile's signature varietal with unique freshness, subtle spice and fresh berry fruits leading to a racy finish



Argentina

330 Septima Obra Malbec 2021/2022 £36

Complex Malbec from Mendoza with intense aromas of black fruit, hints of cocoa and vanilla from ageing

331 Pulenta Estate Malbec (1) 2020 £59

Extremely popular, Argentinian Malbec with an inky, medium-bodied, dry red wine with strong notes of dark fruits on the nose and palate. This wine tends to have mellower tannins than its French counterpart

332 Meg Escorihuela Gascón 2018, Mendoza £80

A red blend of Malbec (60%) and Cabernet Sauvignon (40%) – elegantly complex with vibrant red fruits, the mineral personality of the terroir and well-integrated oaky aromas. Big black fruit of plum, blackcurrant and cassis entwined with perfumed violet and burnt orange peel upon a swift steed of vanilla spice and cocoa

335 Catena Appellation Cabernet Franc 2019 £45

The Catena Appellation Cabernet Franc is brimming with concentrated ripe red berries, a touch of eucalyptus and black pepper, robust tannins and a smooth lengthy finish which is bright and fresh with finely grained tannins

333 Bogle Petite Syrah, California 2018 £47

Full bodied on the entry, aromas of black plum jam and toasty oak

334 Cannonball, Cabernet Sauvignon, California 2019 £60

The taste of Red currant fruit with fresh cherry and berry flavours. The mouthfeel starts with a substantial body and has just enough texture and acidity to leave a long and flavourful finish

336 Cycles Gladiator Pinot Noir, California, Central Coast 2021 £36

Aromas of cherries. The palate is round and supple, medium body with delicate tannins

- 417 Deen Vat 5 Botrytis Semillon 2018 Australia 37.5cl** £30
An elegant sweet white wine with aromas of apricot, citrus and nuttiness. On the palate are flavours of honey, peaches, pears along with nectarines, apricots, candied orange peel as well as a hint of vanilla. The finish is rich and with a good level of acidity to perfectly balance the sweetness

67% Merlot, 21% Cabernet Franc, 12% Cabernet Sauvignon. Château Cantin 2014 has a beautiful garnet colour with ruby tints. The nose, powerful and fruity, offers ripe fruit scents and a spicy note. On the palate, the wine is expressive and well balanced with persistent tannins. The attack, ample and round, delivers cherry, black fruits and coffee notes



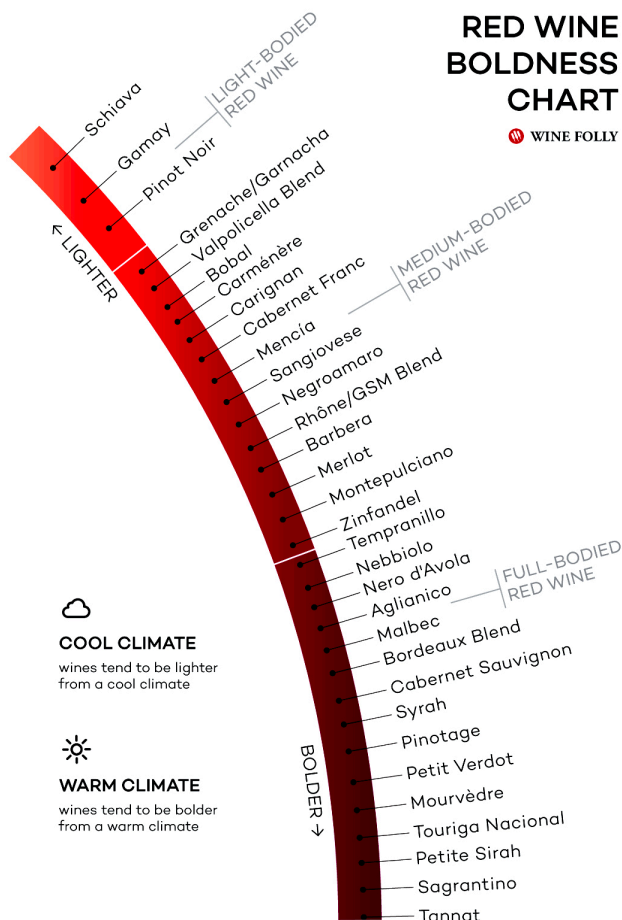
