On the palate, it is fresh, supple, and well-balanced, revealing flavors of candied pear, acacia
honey and a touch of minerality.
- 105 De Castelnau Blanc de Blanc 2008** £105
The palate expresses roasted almonds and hazelnuts while figs, candied lemon and biscuit notes combine
to form an intense and lingering finish
- 106 Deutz Brut Classic NV** £89
The wine initially displays notes of white flowers, toast, marzipan, and ripe pears. Overall, the wine
is well-rounded with a fruity finish
- 108 De Castelnau Brut Rosé NV** £95
Slightly salmon, pink grapefruit in colour. Full and rounded with red berry fruit, subtle mint, and
grilled almond notes

Aromas of white peach, sugar melon, acacia blossom and young pears.
- 110 Cremant de Loire Brut Domaine Mazelles NV France** £42
Pale in colour with notes of baked apples on the nose. The palate has a lovely, soft mousse with
notes of lemon, apple, honeysuckle and brioche
- 111 Court Garden Classic Cuvée, English Sparkling Brut 2018 France** £66
Toasty, with under-ripe pineapple and greengage fruit behind; brut-style, balanced with creamy
mousse and great freshness, and a long finish
- 112 Anna De Codorniu Blanc de Blancs Reserva NV Spain** £40
Citrusy and tropical fruit notes on the nose, along with more complex ageing aromas (toast,
brioche).
- 113 Villa Sandi Prosecco Rosé DOC Millesimato 2023 Italy** £40
Its aromatic freshness offers a bouquet of red fruits and floral scents in particular notes of pomegranate
and rose. On the palate it is silky and full, with a very pleasant balance

Opulent and layered, combining lychee, butter-sautéed mushrooms, natural yoghurt, and fresh oyster

Non-Alcoholic Wines

Red

Odd Bird – The world’s first low intervention wine – liberated from alcohol £33
Supple blend of Merlot and Pinot Noir from Breganze, a town in the Veneto region of Italy. Fermented spontaneously, hand harvested, 100% organic and micro vinified in barriques and tonneaux

White

Odd Bird – The world’s first low intervention wine – liberated from alcohol £33
Rich and Powerful with intense red fruit aromas and a long spicy finish

Moa Gürbüzer started Oddbird in 2013. Her vision was to question and change the alcohol norms of society by creating world class wines but liberating them from alcohol. Today Oddbird is the largest producer of wines liberated from alcohol in Scandinavia.

Odd bird is a Swedish winery, which develops, produces, and distributes non-alcoholic premium wines. Even without alcohol, it is possible to enjoy a wine. The Odd bird wines have their legacy from old classical handicraft, but modern non-alcoholic wines are created with a new patented technology.

Non-Alcoholic Sparkling

ALT. Sparkling Organic Chardonnay £33
A crisp and refreshing non-alcoholic sparkling white wine made with 100% Chardonnay grapes from sandy and calcareous soils in southern Spain. Crisp acidity and strong effervescence with hints of green apples and citrus peel accompanied with a floral aroma

ALT. Sparkling Organic Rosé £33
ALT. Sparkling Organic Rosé is a fresh and aromatic non-alcoholic sparkling rosé wine made with 100% Tempranillo grapes from sandy and calcareous soils in the middle of Spain. Crisp acidity and strong effervescence with hints of summer berries and watermelon accompanied by an aromatic aroma

Pale Gold. Complex, with floral, minty, and exotic fruit notes.

203 Pouilly - Fumé Domaine Chauveau 2023. £42

Stylish expression of Sauvignon Blanc, with an herbaceous bite and gunflint notes on the finish

205 Domaine Roland Tissier Sancerre Blanc 2023 £53

Elegant and refreshing overtones of gooseberry and citrus flavours on the palate

La Bourgogne

Chablis

207 Pascal Bouchard Chablis Le Classique 2023 £45

Subtle aromas of tree fruit and hints of citrus show nicely in this elegant unoaked Chardonnay

208 Pascal Bouchard Chablis Grand Cru Vaudésir 2019. £98

'Vaudésirs' is nestled in a micro-valley with pleasing minerality, toasted, oaky notes, suppleness, and remarkable ageing potential.

Mâconnais

209 Pouilly - Fuissé Les Deux Terroirs, Mommessin 2022/2023. £64

A classic Burgundy Chardonnay, rich and buttery with lovely acidity

211 Ropiteau Macon Lugny 2023 £45

A fresh and complex with flavours of white flowers and dried fruits with subtle notes of acacia.

Côte Chalonnaise

215 Montagny 1er Cru Seguin-Manuel 2022 £85

Elegant, open nose with notes of ripe fruit, toasty nuances and minerality. Expressive and precise on the palate. The mid-palate is full and finishes on mineral and vanilla nuances

Côte de Beaune

514 Puligny Montrachet Ropiteau Grand Vin De Bourgogne 2023 £95

A classy Puligny-Montrachet with seductive aromas of white peach, apricot and buttery notes, which is elegantly structured and supported by delicious minerality

Southern Rhône

216 Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc 2021. £70

A brilliant pale gold with pear, apricot notes. Mineral notes and a balance aromatic fruit



Italy

217 Almorano Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie 2024 £36

A widely planted Sicilian variety which gives texture and tropical fruit flavours to the wine. Vegetarian and Vegan

218 Gavi di Gavi, Roberto Sarotto (Piemonte) 2023 £41

White peach notes on the nose leading onto more stone fruit on the palate as well as delicious honeydew melon. Cortese grape variety

219 Telavè Vermentino di Jerzu Sardinia 2023 £42

The nose is perfumed and lifted, with aromas of fresh citrus fruit and hints of fennel.

Spain

220 Raimat Saira Albariño 2024 £41

Refreshing wine with enjoyable aromas of dried flowers and lemon peel with nuances of green apple and wet grass

South Africa

222 Ken Forrester 'The FMC' Chenin Blanc 2023 £80

Layer upon layer of candied lemon, dried apricot, and vanilla, with a touch of honey and spice supported by a gentle oak and a lovely freshness

Australia

223 Elizabeth Cellar Aged Hunter Valley Semillon 2018 £50

Mouth-filling and textural yet impeccably pure. Expect intense lime and green apple flavors layered with toast, lemon butter, honeyed wax, lanolin and a mineral edge.

New Zealand

224 Esk Valley Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough 2024 £39

Refreshing wine with zesty citrus flavours and a touch of fresh herbs. It has a lovely mineral character with a zesty acidity, leading to a long, dry finish

225 Dog Point Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2022/2023 £49

Typically a very crisp aromatic wine with notes of grapefruit, tropical fruit and cut grass

Chile

226 Altitudes Gran Reserve Viognier Chile 2023/2024 £40

Medium-full bodied with rich aromas of citrus, apricot and fresh pears. The palate is rich as well with floral, honeyed and citrus flavours and a touch of minerality



Argentina

227 Catena Alta Chardonnay 2020 £61

A remarkable white wine, with flavours of pear, apricot and lemon. There are subtle hints of white flowers and warm, smoky notes on the finish

250 Inacayal Torrontes Mendoza 2020 £40

Aromas displaying mineral and floral notes typically jasmine, geranium, orange blossom, together with fruit notes of lychee.

Germany

230 Dr Loosen Dry Slate Red Riesling 2021 £41

Zesty citrus (lime, lemon), subtle tropical hints (pineapple, mango), and a clean, mineral-driven finish

Beaujolais

301 Fleurie Mommessin 2022 £40
It offers a rich nose of black fruit and floral with hints of spice and dark chocolate.

302 Mommessin Château de Pierreux Brouilly 2022 £41
Brilliant deep ruby in colour with an elegant aroma of soft floral notes of violet and peonies

La Vallée du Rhône

303 Domaine de Longue Toque, Gigondas 2016 £59
Rich and Powerful with intense red fruit aromas and a long spicy finish

304 Les Hauts de Barville Rouge Châteauneuf de Pape 2022 £84
Inky ruby colour, this Rhone ranger displays roasted dark berry, cherry preserve and plum aromas

305 Crozes-Hermitage Domaine Les Alexandrins 2020/2022 £71
An intense ruby red with an abundance of red fruits on the nose by an undertone of violets.

La Bourgogne

Côte de Beaune

306 Domaine Ferrandier, Pinot Noir 2023 £36
This charming wine features predominant fruity aromas of blackcurrant and wild red berries.

307 Albert Bichot, Secret de Famille, Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2021 £60
Notes of red berries like raspberry and cherry. Hints of blackcurrant, subtle earthiness, and a touch of spice

Bordeaux

Saint Émilion

308 Château Billeron Bouquey, Grand Cru 2021/2022 £45
A rich, mouth-drying tannic structure, which is balanced by the more juicy characteristics of plum and black cherry fruit, along with chocolate, sweet spice, vanilla and tobacco

Pomerol

309 Château Plaisance Lalande de Pomerol 2022 £45
Red and black fruit aromas mingle on the nose such as redcurrant, blackcurrant, wild berries.

Margaux

310 La Bastide Dauzac 2021 £70
Deep purple colour with ruby undertone. Subtle tannins, well balance wine with a silk texture



Saint Julien

- 312 Les Fiefs de Lagrange 2019** £77
The wine is characterized by round tannins, aromas of red and black fruits

Saint-Estèphe

- 314 Corsair de Lafitte Carcasset 2019** £50
It is an elegant and fruity wine with refined oaky notes and a round, smooth texture

Pauillac

- 501 Lacoste Borie 2018** £87
The palate is medium bodied with a beautiful ruby red colour, very intense red berries aromas and spicy notes and cassis

Italy

Puglia, South 'Italy Heel'

- 316 Integro Negroamaro Organic IGP 2022** £40
An organic ruby-red wine with aromas of red fruit, currant jam, raspberries, and black pepper
- 319 Borgo Del Mandorlo Rosso Appassimento 2023** £40
This wine features a deep ruby red color and aromas of dried fruits, blackcurrant, and vanilla

Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Northern Italy

- 320 Borgo Conventi Refosco Rosso DOC 2022** £40
Lively, with a harmonious balance of ripe red fruit, gentle tannins, and a persistent, savory finish

Piedmont, North West

- 317 Barolo DOCG Ascheri Sorano 2020** £85
Notes of tar, dried roses, and truffle. Hints of leather and sweet spices like clove and cinnamon
- 318 Prunotto Pian Romualdo Barbera d'Alba 2021** £64
Notes of ripe black fruit, especially plum and black cherry. Accents of spice, earth, and a touch of vanilla from oak aging

Tuscany, Central

- 321 La Braccasca Nobile di Montepulciano DOCG 2020** £69
Notes of violet, blood orange, and dark cherry. Hints of lavender, cedar shavings, and subtle oak spice

Sardinia

- 322 Cantina Mesa Buio, Rosso, Carignano del Sulcis 2023** £46
Notes of ripe red berries (cherry, raspberry). Accents of Mediterranean herbs (thyme, rosemary)

Veneto

- 315 Còrpore, Merlot, Montello E Colli Asolani, DOC, 2020** £65
Notes of red fruit jam with the spicy ones of pepper, cocoa and nutmeg. The sip, which brings the same suggestions to the taste, is soft, balanced and persistent.

323 Museum Reserva 2019 £56
Aromas of black cherry, ripe plum, and cranberry. Accents of vanilla, cedar, tobacco leaf, and sweet spices

Rioja

324 Cune Rioja Gran Reserva 2018 £48
Attractive aroma of blackberries, blackcurrants and raspberries blended with a hint of spice and vanilla.

325 Rioja Imperial Gran Reserva 2015 £100
Full garnet in colour expressing elegant autumn berry fruits, coffee, caramel, and cinnamon

Australia

Coal River Valley, Tasmania

326 Giant Steps Pinot Noir 2019 £83
Layers of dark berries, spice, and earthy complexity supported by fine tannins and lively acidity

Victoria, Murray Darling Region

327 Deakin Estate Shiraz 2021 £40
Rich, smooth and juicy displaying classic flavours of ripe red berries, plum, hints of vanilla and spice

South Africa

Swartland

328 Painted Wolf 'Guillermo' Pinotage 2021 £46
Flavours of ripe blueberry and mulberry, exotic spice, and creamy vanilla with ripe tannins

Stellenbosch

329 Circumstance Merlot 2019 £45
Notes of dense cassis, bramble berries, and plum. Accents of cedary spice, bitter chocolate, and earthy undertones

Argentina

330 Septima Obra Malbec 2022/2023 £39
Complex Malbec with intense aromas of black fruit, hints of cocoa and vanilla from ageing

335 Catena Appellation Cabernet Franc 2021 £48
Notes of raspberry, black cherry, and plum. Accents of eucalyptus, black pepper, and dried herbs

United States of America

334 Cannonball, Cabernet Sauvignon, California 2020/2021 £65
Notes of blackberry, mulberry, and cherry compote. Accents of mocha, graphite, clove, and violet

336 Cycles Gladiator Pinot Noir, California, Central Coast 2021 £40
Aromas of cherries. The palate is round and supple, medium body with delicate tannins



Rosé Wine

- 401 Almorano Pinot Grigio delle Venezie Rosé 2023.** £36
A rich and Fruity Rosé wine from delle Venezie. A Unique pale-copper colour; aromatic with delicate citrus notes; crisp and refreshing on the palate
- 402 Barbebelles Provence Rosé 2023/2024.** £39
A classic Provence rosé with fresh red fruit aromas and flavours of redcurrant
- 403 Les Commandeurs Rosé AOP Côtes de Provence 2024** £50
Intense fruitiness and light style, it is thirst-quenching and perfect for all the good times of summer
- 404 Whispering Angel Côtes de Provence Rosé 2023** £57
Fresh aroma and notes of citrus and pink grapefruit, smooth and creamy feel on the palate
- 405 Sauvion Rosé d'Anjou Chemin des Sables 2024.** £36
Off-dry to medium-sweet with juicy red-berry flavors strawberry, cherry, and raspberry

Dessert Wine

- 410 Château de Fesles Bonnezeaux 2014 France 50cl.** £60
A smooth, harmonious wine with an appealing combination of flavours and aromas
- 411 Lothian Noble Late Harvest 2018 South Africa 37.5cl.** £40
Notes of pineapple, brown sugar, lemon and honey. This wine would pair well with strong cheeses both soft and hard, roasted nuts, dried fruits, and even a not-too-sweet cheesecake
- 412 La Pigeade, Muscat De Beaumes-de-Venise 2023 France 37.5cl** £42
Aromas of orange blossom, lychee, rose petals, ginger, pineapple and mango on the palate.
- 413 Peller Estate Vidal, Niagara 2018 Canada 37.5cl** £85
Clean fruit flavours of peach, pear juice, tangerine and just a hint of honey excite the palate. A lingering finish, apricot and candied citrus peel
- 416 Carmes de Rieussec, Sauternes 2022 France 37.5cl** £42
Delicate aromas and flavours of hibiscus and honey, plus orchard fruit and honey.
Elegant, fresh, juicy and vibrant
- 417 Deen Vat 5 Botrytis Semillon 2020 Australia 35.7cl** £28
An elegant sweet white wine with aromas of apricot, citrus and nuttiness. On the palate are flavours of honey, peaches, pears along with nectarines, candied orange peel as well as a hint of vanilla

Magnums

- 518 Château Lamothe Haut Médoc 2019** £97
Aerating the wine displays a large spectrum of aroma: blackcurrant and jammy fruits associated with soft spices and subtle vanilla
- 519 Château Cantin, Grand Cru, Saint Émilion 2018/2020** £115
The nose, powerful and fruity, offers ripe fruit scents and a spicy note. The attack, ample and round, delivers cherry, black fruits and coffee notes
